and then, how he personally helped me – he was on the nyfa committee that awarded me a nyfa in poetry/1993. forever grateful.

the last occasion I saw miguel, on new years day evening, sitting at lower east side spot with nancy mercado, some others. doing what we all like to do, hanging out, laughing. just his presence – knowing he is there –

anyway, thanks miguel, you are irrepressible, irreplaceable, and missed.
